

## Relimile Emiverquil

If you want to say someone is noisy you can say - **He is as noisy as** an elephant. That's a good simile but we can make it better! We need to think of something noisier than an elephant. **He is as noisy as a herd of elephants**.

We can make it even better still - He is as noisy as a herd of angry elephants! Now that's a Super Simile!

### Multiple Meaning Similes Some adjectives can have more than one meaning. We can say, Tom is as bright as day. Bright has two meanings, it can mean shiny or clever. Using the second meaning makes for an interesting simile. Try making some similes with the second meaning of the
